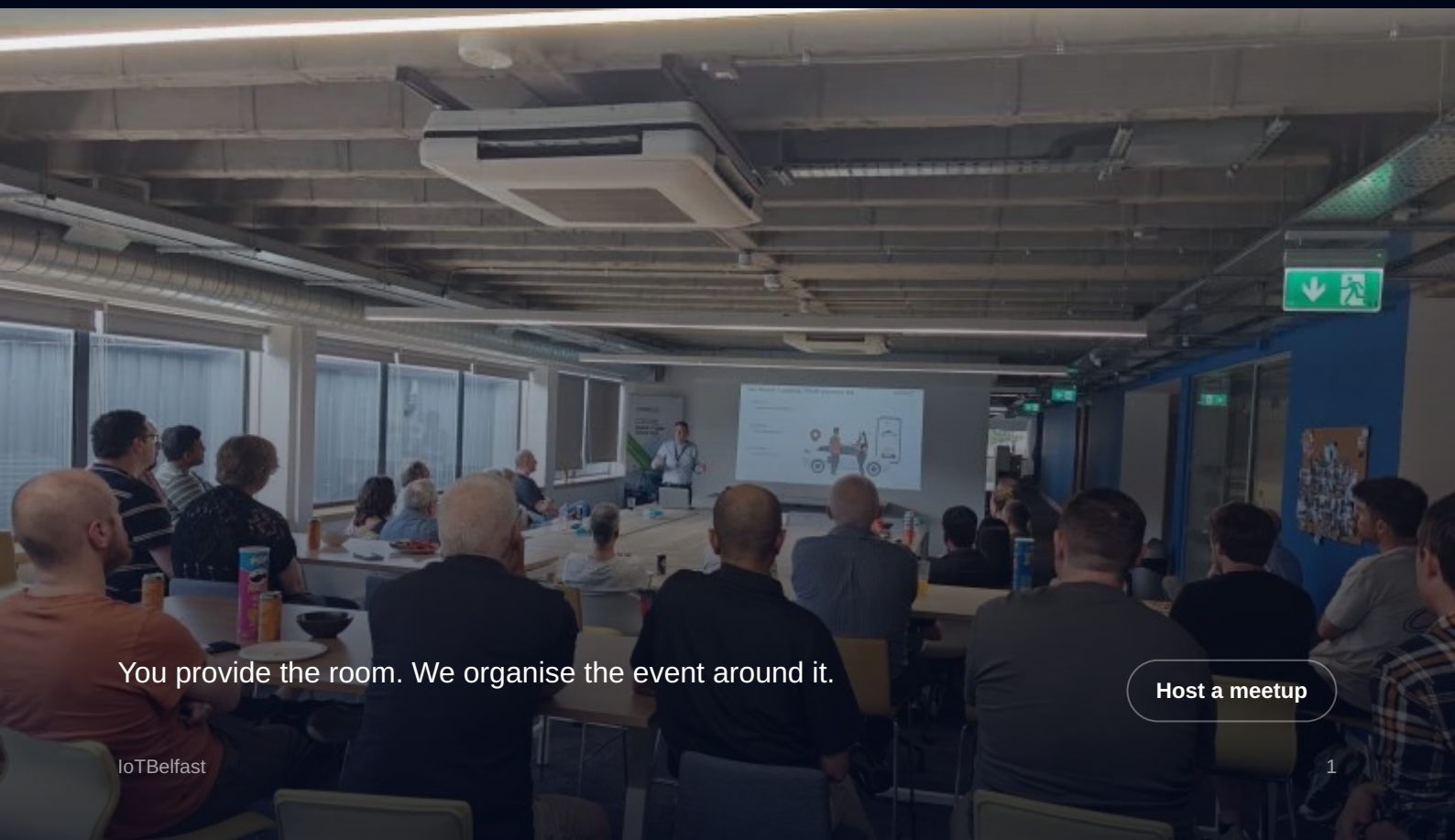


Put Belfast's IoT community in your room.

Hosting IoT Belfast gives your team and the wider community a practical evening of lightning talks, questions and useful conversation.



You provide the room. We organise the event around it.

A good room and the basics people need to use it.

01

Accessible Belfast venue

Seated presentation space plus enough room for people to talk before and afterwards.

02

Screen & AV

A dependable screen/projector, presentation connection and audio where the room needs it.

03

Practical access

Clear arrival instructions, building access, toilets and anything attendees need to know in advance.

04

A few possible dates

Give us a realistic window and we can work the programme around the room.



Useful visibility, useful conversations, and a reason to bring people into your space.

Event-page credit

Your organisation is named and linked as the host on the permanent event record.

Social visibility

Host credit appears in relevant event announcements, graphics and the post-event thank-you.

Recap backlink

Where a recap is published, the host is credited in the longer community record too.

Team access

Your own people get a useful technical evening without leaving the workplace ecosystem they already know.

Hosts can help shape the theme and suggest speakers. IoT Belfast keeps the final call on programme fit so the evening still works for the wider community.

From a room to a live meetup in four steps.

01

Talk

Tell us about the space, possible dates and anything you want the community to explore.

02

Shape the theme

We agree a useful subject and start lining up the lightning-talk programme.

03

Promote it

IoT Belfast builds the event page, Meetup listing and event communications.

04

Open the room

We run the talks, questions and community follow-up, then keep the permanent event record live.



IoT Belfast moves around the city.

The variety is part of the point. The meetup has worked with local employers, universities, public bodies and technology organisations rather than becoming tied to one venue.



If your team has a room and a subject worth discussing, that is enough to start.
